SHOW RULES

- 1 **THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
- 2 **ENTRY FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE AFTER THE CLOSE OF ENTRIES** – even with a Doctor / Veterinary Certificate. Exhibitors wishing to request a refund of entry fees must apply in writing by midnight on the **22nd July 2022.**
- 3 **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY FULL PAYMENT.**
- 4 **COMPETITOR NUMBERS MUST BE WORN / CLEARLY** displayed at all times whilst mounted. This includes working in / exercising around the showground.
- 5 **ALL RIDDEN ANIMALS MUST BE 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER.** The age of the animal shall be calculated from the 1st January in the year of its birth.
- 6 **ALL EQUINES MUST BE LED, RIDDEN OR DRIVEN AND UNDER THE CONTROL** of a competent person at all times. Handlers of Lead Rein ponies must be at least **14** years of age
- 7 **EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO CARRY PASSPORTS** for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a Trading Standards requirement that the passport must be in the name of the legal owner.
- 8 **NO PERSON SHALL ILL-TREAT ANIMALS AT ANY TIME** whether by misuse/excessive use of a whip, bit or any item of saddlery or in any other way whatsoever.
- 9 **AGE OF RIDERS** – is taken from the 1st January in the current year unless stated otherwise in the schedule. All riders competing in any showing class must have attained their **3rd** birthday by the date of the show.
- 10 **FALL OF HORSE / RIDER** – a fall or horse or rider while mounted in any class will result in disqualification and they **MUST** leave the ring dismounted.
- 11 **HATS** – correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps / Riding Hats that meet current BSI safety standards of: PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards **MUST** be worn by all riders. Handlers of horses / ponies competing in Handler / In Hand classes aged 14 years & under must wear a secured current BSI standard Skull / Riding Hat.
- 12 **BITS / BRIDLES** - In all classes, unless otherwise stated, any suitable bit is acceptable.
- 13 **EARRINGS / PIERCINGS** – in the interest of safety, no ear rings, piercings or visible jewellery should be worn whilst competing.
- 14 **SPURS/DRESS SPURS** must **NOT** be worn in any Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony or any Ridden Mountain and Moorland showing class.
- 15 **SHOW CANES** – are not to exceed 75cms (30”).
- 16 **HANDLES ON SADDLES** – are permitted in Lead Rein classes.
- 17 **MOBILE PHONES** – must not be taken into the ring.
- 18 **STALLIONS** – in the interest of safety, stallions may only be ridden or handled by persons over the age of **14 years** – with the exception of Small Breeds Mountain & Moorland stallions, where the rider / handler must have attained their **12th birthday** by the 1st January in the current year. Stallions are not permitted in any Young Handler, Equitation, Junior Ridden M&M, Lead Rein or First Ridden classes.

WELCOME TO SHOWFEST

ShowFest is the new concept in showing intended to bring fun back to the Show Ring. The show is aimed at all ages of Amateur and Home-Produced riders who want to compete, learn and most importantly have fun with like minded riders. We are running a variety of different classes for all shapes and types of horses and ponies, interspersed with fun competitions and activities. If you have always wanted to learn more about Judging, this is your opportunity to find out what the Judge is looking for – and then discuss the class afterwards with an experienced Panel Judge. If you want to learn what a Show Steward does, we will have many experienced Stewards on hand who would be delighted to show you what goes on and you will find out how valuable Stewards are to every show. We will have Training classes with Professional Trainers and Producers who will give some tips on how to improve – whether you want to improve your individual display or learn how to turn out your horse or pony to emphasise their best qualities. Every class has been allocated an hour and entries will be restricted so the Judge will have plenty of time to assess and offer feedback to riders. If your individual show does not go quite as planned, there may be time to try it again before leaving the show ring. All ShowFest ridden classes will be judged on a mark system so that you can see how and where you can improve.

For the competitively minded, we are offering qualifiers for several Championship shows around the country. Come to one show and qualify for Equifest, South-West Ponies Association, The Showing Register, SSADL's classes at the London Horse Show, The Veteran Horse Society Championships or the new Rising Star qualifiers at the British Show Horse Association Show. We are also delighted to be running qualifiers on Sunday for SEIB's NEW Search for a Star Pony Club qualifiers – with the finals hosted at Your Horse Live in November. **Please note** – these classes will be run under the individual Association's rules and you must be eligible in order to qualify.

During the lunch breaks and after the showing classes finish at 5pm, we will have Scurry Driving taking place in the Main Ring. The louder you cheer, the faster they go, so put your horse or pony away for a rest and go and cheer on your favourites. If you have always wanted to learn more about scurry driving, talk to the competitors to find out how to get into this fast and furious sport.

For the young and young at heart, relax with our daily colouring competitions – with prizes for the Judge's choice every day. If you have always wanted to perform or have a talent that you want to show off, then our Talent Competition will be the place to head to. Does your pet have a trick that you are proud of? Head to **ShowFest** before applying for Britain's Got Talent and let us be your first audience. Do you always answer the questions on the TV Quiz Shows? Our Team Quiz will give you the opportunity to shine. Is your dog your pride and joy? Take part in our fun Dog Show – where they can compete with other cute and handsome pet dogs to win the **ShowFest Best in Show** title.

On Sunday, we are finishing the weekend off with our Awards Ceremony. These awards will be open only to riders that are stabling on site for the three days. The judging will be made by our team of **Talent Spotters** who will be looking out for horses, riders and grooms who stand out and deserve recognition. Categories include:

- Most Improved
- Best Turned out Horse & Rider
 - Best Rider
 - Best Kept Stable
 - Best Dressed Groom
- ShowFest Star Award

We are offering two ways to enter ShowFest. If you would like to stay for the three days and get the most out of the experience, we have 240 permanent stables on site. Competitors can arrive on Thursday afternoon and get settled in before joining the Welcome party on Thursday evening. The price of **£295.00** includes one stable, up to 4 showing classes per day and as many of the other activities that you want to take part in. This is perfect for the entire family – so while one person is competing, the others can take part in any of the other activities. The price is worked out per horse / pony – NOT per person – so if you have several riders or handlers for your equine friend, they can all take part within the price structure. Alternatively, if you just want to come for the day, entries are £15.00 / class – or £20.00 for late entries or entries on the day (subject to availability).

METHOD OF JUDGING FOR SHOWFEST RIDDEN CLASSES

All ridden classes (except the Training Classes) will be judged on a mark system and individual mark cards will be given to every rider at the end of the class. Some classes will have a mark awarded for the “type” and “conformation” of the horse / pony and others will be awarded on the performance of horse/pony or rider only. The method of judging will be indicated in the schedule by the class description. Please note – the marks awarded in each class may vary according to the different Judge’s preferences. The marks are intended only as a guide to how your horse / pony performed in that class on the day and give you elements of your individual show that you can improve upon.

Lead Rein and First Ridden ponies will be judged primarily on the suitability of the pony to safely carry their young jockeys either on the lead rein or as a first ridden pony. These classes will not be judged on conformation or type, although they will be divided into Native/ Native Type and Plaited ponies for judging purposes. If any class is being judged differently than below, the method of judging will be stated by the class description.

RULES FOR BSHA RISING STAR

Classes: 65, 68, 70, 82, 91 held on Saturday 13th August.
BSHA Rising Star Classes which must be entered into the spirit in which they are intended:

1. Open to BSHA Non-Members and Amateur Members. Owners, Riders and Horses, are not required to be Members of the British Show Horse Association in-order to compete in the BSHA Rising Star qualifying classes, the Rising Star Finals will require a day ticket.
2. These classes are specifically aimed at those Horses and Riders who are not regularly qualifying for the major Championship Shows and wish to improve.
3. Riders must not have competed at The Royal International Horse Show or The Horse of the Year Show, with the exception of the BSHA RIHS Amateur classes pre-2022 or SEIB Search for a Star.
4. Open to Horses which are stabled at home or in a DIY or non-show yard.
5. Horses to be ridden by an Amateur, please see the current BSHA Rule Book; this does not exclude receiving lessons from a Professional showing person.
6. No Professional is allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form), compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse.
7. Failure to abide by the Rules may result in ineligibility to compete at the BSHA National Championship Show in any class.
8. The Judge will ride ALL the exhibits in the final.
9. To register for the Supreme Final at the BSHA National Championships Show on the **10th September** you must upload your details on our website using the details on the back of the qualifying rosette.



VETERAN HORSE SOCIETY REGIONAL FINALS

Classes: 153, 154, 159, 170, 171, 173, 174 held on Sunday 14th August.
Regional Finals are open to QUALIFIED VHS MEMBERS only.

1. To compete in a Regional final competitors must be fully paid up members of the VHS with a valid membership card. You must also have a VHS Showing card with a valid Regional Final qualification signature.
2. You will be asked to show both of these cards to the Steward on entering the ring and will not be allowed to enter without them.
3. No substitution of horse/pony or rider/handler will be allowed.
4. Competitors may attend up to 4 Regional Finals in any one year, providing they are within an acceptable travelling distance. If a competitor is seen to be "chasing" Regional Finals this may lead to their membership being revoked.
5. Supreme Final qualification - 1st & 2nd placed competitors in each class will qualify for the Supreme Final and will have the Supreme Final section of their showing card signed by the Judge in the ring. Entries to the Supreme Final must be made within 21 days of the qualifying show date. Late entries for the final will not be accepted. If the competitor has already qualified or does not wish to attend they must refuse the qualification and pass it down the line on the day of the show.
6. M&M Supreme Final qualification – to be awarded at the Judge's discretion. The highest placed registered M&M shown in its natural state in each class will qualify for the M&M Supreme Final at the National Veteran Championships and will have the M&M Supreme Final section of their showing card signed by the Judge in the ring. It is possible for an M&M to qualify for both the Supreme final and the M&M Supreme Final. Entries to the M&M Supreme Final must be made within 21 days of the qualifying show date. Late entries for the final will not be accepted. If the competitor has already qualified or does not wish to attend they must refuse the qualification and pass it down the line on the day of the show.
7. Horses / ponies will be stripped.
